Debit vs. Credit

A quick word of warning for those of you
who buy gas with your Debit card... most
gas stations place a sizable hold on your
funds whenever you swipe your card at the
pump no matter how small your purchase
(Cumberland Farms = \$75.00). These
funds can be held for several days. This
could increase the likelihood of overdrafts
for those who keep a low balance in their
account.

The easiest way to avoid this problem is to
press CREDIT when swiping your Debit
card at a gas station.
