PREVENTING Identity Theft

Checking your accounts daily or looking at your monthly statement could save you from the headaches of identity theft. Here are ways to keep your personal information safe:

- Review your credit report annually for any suspicious activity. See our loan department for more information.
- Shred all confidential documents including credit card offers.
- Use secure mailboxes to send and receive mail.
- Never reply to e-mail or telephone calls that claim to need your account information, PIN numbers, passwords or Social Security number.
- Never cash a check, money order or cashier's check for another person. The check may be counterfeit and you would be responsible for the funds.
- If you're selling an item and the buyer offers you a check for more than the asking price and asks for cash back, don't do it! The check may be fraud or may bounce and you will be liable.
