For a savings deposit use you savings account number (without trailers) in the account section.

For checking use the

MICR number at the bottom of your checks beginning with the number 7. Your ABA number is 2112-88653.

FYI: Federal deposits are on Fridays. State reimbursement deposits vary.

Do NOT use a club account as it will be rejected.

Safe Deposit Box Fees

Annual fees will be due on April 1st and will be withdrawn from your savings account. Please be sure to have the available funds in your account to avoid fees.

• Pay yourself first. Sign up to have a fixed amount automatically taken out of

your paycheck to go directly into your savings account or investments. When you pay yourself first, you won't even miss the money after it's gone.

- Expecting a raise this year? Pretend you're not. Don't change your spending habits. Deposit the extra money and use it to reach your savings goals.
- Interest payments can take quite a chunk out of your cash supply. Always take out the shortest term possible on loans, pay credit card bills in full by the due date or pay as much as you can beyond the minimum payment.

or mortgages. Pay more on your loan payments monthly to pay off the loan quickly.

- Clip coupons to help save money on groceries, household supplies and even restaurants.
