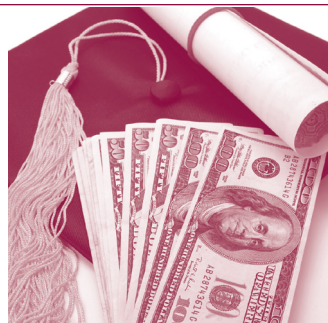
A Founding Father Passes

In 2013, the Credit Union placed 23rd in the State of Maine for total funds raised for Maine Credit Unions' Campaign for Ending Hunger and placed 11th in 'per member' contributions. The total of all funds raised throughout Maine, Maine Credit Unions came in at a record breaking \$513,309.02. Since 1990, Maine Credit Unions' Campaign for Ending Hunger has raised more than \$5.3 million for Ending Hunger. The credit union wishes to thank all of our members for their continued support throughout the years along with the organizations listed above for their selfless hours spent in effort to help those in need.
